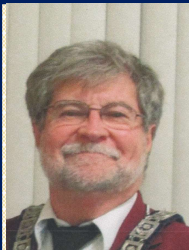

Keep looking at the bugle and online calendar so you don't miss out. There's something going on almost every night!!

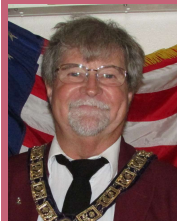

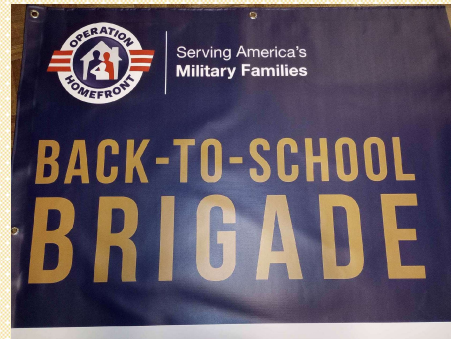
