

You too can display support of our Veterans and Military by purchasing the "We Honor Those Who Serve" patch and wearing it proudly.



The Brandon Lodge #2383, spearheaded by their Veteran Chair Robin Rutzke, continues to support their Veterans.

On October 13th Veteran Chair Robin Rutzke representing the Brandon lodge, presented \$725 worth of art supplies and \$75 in Wal-Mart gift cards to the recreation therapy services of the James A. Haley Hospital. The donation was presented to Kim Peatee Felt, recreation therapist who works in Short Stay Rehabilitation and Whole Health at James A. Haley, and to Marina Leander, recreation therapist, who works in the Spinal Cord Injury Center. These gifts were made possible by donations by Brandon members as well as member fundraisers for Veteran causes. The gifts will be shared by all of recreation therapy at James A. Haley.

With the monetary donations, Robin purchased acrylic paints, premium paint brushes, paint markers, watercolor essentials kits, canvas panels, colored pencils, sketch books. The gift cards will supplement any additional items needed.

In addition, Brandon member Ken Muzyk and Robin Rutzke donated puzzles and karaoke CD's. Brandon lodge members donated loads of magazines. Robin also reached out to the Elks National Veterans Service Commission "Playing Cards for Veterans" program, requesting playing cards for the recreation therapy and POC Tom Jamison personally responded to Robin and within a week 75 decks of playing cards arrived which Robin donated to James A. Haley.

Robin works very closely with her contacts at James A. Haley to ensure the items donated meet their needs.

The Brandon lodge has a long-standing partnership with James A. Haley. Veteran Chair Robin Rutzke continues to build on this relationship especially throughout the COVID pandemic to ensure our Veterans are not forgotten!


The month of November for bags of brotherly has been a busy one thus far with assembling the bags and distributing them as well. By November 12th, 65 bags were distributed and over 100 bags have been assembled and ready for the next outreach. The next homeless outreach event will be conducted at Sacred Heart Church in Tampa on January 11th, 2022. We will continue to assemble the bags in anticipation of receiving approximately 250 homeless at the event. If anyone would like to help volunteer their services for the day on January 11th, please contact Bob at the below number. Unfortunately, we do not have a flyer yet as the meetings are ongoing to prepare for the outreach. We anticipate a flyer by December and should have it in January's bugle. Again, we thank all our members for their continued contributions of clothing and hygiene items that continue to be utilized by the homeless. Through the partnership that Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office has with Frito Lay, we were given 25 boxes of assorted chips and snacks to be put into the bags of brotherly love. We continue to also work with the Homeless Initiative to ensure safety protocols are in place for the upcoming outreach and get monthly reports of the current Covid issues within the county. We appreciate our members continued support of this worthy project that demonstrates Elks Care, Elks Share within the homeless communities. Bringing dignity back to the lives of those less fortunate is a constant reminder of how the bags of brotherly love help in these trying times and especially at the holiday season. Generosity of our members time and donations for this endeavor are appreciated by all the partners we serve as they continue to find housing, provide medical assistance, and help homeless, many of them being veterans. We are proud that Brandon lodge Elk members help to ensure that continues. May everyone have a blessed holiday season. Hope to see you at the lodge.



No vulgarity, profanity, politics, or meanness are permitted on our Open page or Private group.





The group a closed one, with only Brandon Elks, spouses, prospective Elks, other lodge's members, Elk campers, and special lodge friends as members. Members may ONLY invite Elks and prospective Elks into this private group. You can invite from the group's main page. Invitees are permitted into the group once verified. Any member can post in this group. Anything posted here is only viewable by the members of this group.

Photos of our events always welcome.

Brandon Elks Lodge 2383 FB Public Page (viewable to anyone on FB)

Public Page - This is where we can advertise events that are open to the public (i.e., Sunday Breakfasts, Bingo, Vets Night, etc.) This also is where we can brag to the world about the many accomplishments of our organizations. It is not used to publicize private events like member parties and Friday night dinners.

You may post directly to Brandon Elks Lodge 2383, but until reviewed and shared by a page administrator it will not show to the public. The Page administrators will include at least one Governing Board member. Facebook notifies page admins when a post is made to the public page. A review and public share of the post will be made as soon possible if deemed appropriate by page administrators. Appropriateness of posts is to be determined by the page administrators. Only the Governing Board can over-ride the page administrators.

Any 'Open to Public' events at the lodge will need prior approval by the Governing Board to be advertised on the open page. Approval needs to be communicated to page admins prior to post.


