



When the hospital became no longer practical, the hospital was sold, and the investment fund was created. Its purpose was, and continues to be, the collection of donations and the acceptance of endowed gifts. The trust fund is restricted, which means that only the *income* derived from it may be used to support our major projects (all donations are added to the principle, and the principle is never spent). These projects are the *Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services* and the *Florida Elks Youth Camp* programs. Of everything that we Florida Elks do, we take the most pride in what we do for our state's children. By continuing our commitment to our youth, our children are given the opportunity to heal, grow, and learn beyond their dreams.

We, as a Lodge, support the Fund. We contributed around \$4.51 per member so far this year. But as you may guess, they could use more. That is why I support the sustaining member program. Through this program, you can make monthly donations automatically. You can give as little or as much as you want. For as little as the price of a gourmet cup of coffee, just one a month, you can help put another Therapist on the road, making a child's life so much better.






