**Brandon Lodge Delivers 100 Gift Bags to Patience of James A. Haley Veteran Hospital**

The Brandon Lodge #2383, in collaboration with the Brandon Ladies of Elks (BLOE), presented 100 gift bags to James A. Haley Veterans Hospital (JAHVH). Doing things for our Veterans has always been important to our lodge and ladies. Donna Manusco-Fultz, BLOE chair, said it is a passion of hers because her dad was a veteran and was cared for in JAHVH before he passed. Robin Rutzke, Brandon Veteran Chair worked with Donna and our BLOE Ladies to put together the 100 gift bags for delivery. Each bag had approximately \$50 worth of items in them. Eighty-five of the bags contained gifts specifically for men and 15 gift bags had specific items for women veterans. On January 23rd, Grants Coordinator and SWCD PDDGER Sharon Hammersla delivered the gift bags to JAHVH for the Veterans in the Spinal Cord Injury Center and Polytrauma. Excess bags were donated to recreational therapy at the hospital.

Both our Elk members and our BLOE Ladies participated in packing of items in the gift bags. The goods for the gift bags were purchased using \$1,000 of the Freedom Grant awarded to our lodge, and with a donation of \$2,000 made by an Elk member and widow of an Elk (who wishes to remain anonymous), combined with over \$300 in donated items from our members and BLOE Ladies. Each bag contained a \$20 Patriot Coupon Book purchased with the \$2,000 donation by the anonymous donor. Patients can use the coupon book to purchase items in the hospital's Canteen Store, cafeteria, Starbucks and barbershop.

Our Brandon lodge has been donating and delivering gift bags to the patients of JAHVH for many years. Our lodge and our ladies work together supporting our Veterans. It is a passion of our lodge and ladies, and we are dedicated to bringing a smile to our Veterans, making sure they know they are not forgotten and that our Elks and Ladies are and always will be there for them.

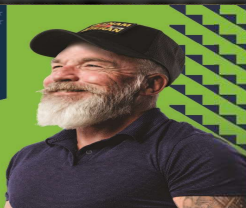
