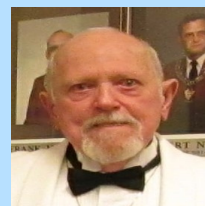

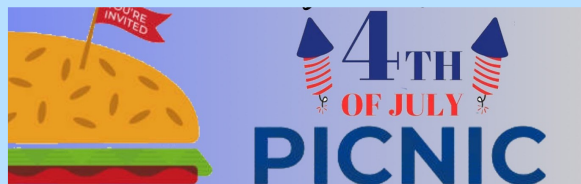
### ATTENTION: RV STORAGE LOT OCCUPANTS

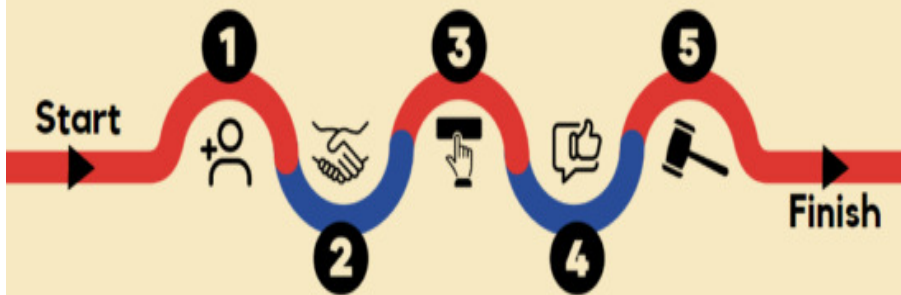
