My agenda is three pronged, increase membership, increase the visibility of our lodge, and invest in ourselves and the community. Although, I plan to address one prong, it will naturally assist in the other areas of focus

As to the first prong, membership, We plan to send invitation letters to selected industries, to join members of our Elks community for a sit-down dinner, at no cost. The event will introduce these invitees to Elkdom and what we do throughout Brandon. A PowerPoint presentation with a narration showing what we are doing to visualize our work is planned. With our intention to join the Chamber of Commerce and other organizations, we are likely to find folks with the same goals and desires as our own and possibly, memberships. Adding members requires visibility.

How do we become VISIBLE in the community? A monthly meeting with newspaper editors, discussing what we are doing and getting this information published. Entering parades and handing out Elk paraphernalia. But to be really seen, bright color shirts with "Brandon Elks Lodge See What We Do?" on the front, with back listing the events with which we conduct and participate. A number of planned events are things we did in the past. Mystery bus to lodges, a bus to the Florida Elks Camp, attendance at Rays games and local college events, are some of the member events of the past we wish to continue. The focus on members will provide opportunities to intermingle with new faces, learn more about one another and maybe find new friends.




