Message From Your Exalted Ruler

February is here and this is always a busy month for our Lodge. There are many things to attend to. The first order of business is to nominate officers for the next Lodge year. These nominations take place at the Lodge's first general membership meeting of the month (the second Monday), which is February 12th this year. If candidates for offices are un-opposed, a single unanimous vote is cast in favor of the un-opposed candidate, thereby electing them to office by acclamation, and nominations for those offices are closed. If there are multiple candidates for an office, elections for that office will be held at the second general membership meeting of the month (the fourth Monday), Feb. 26th this year. If there are offices for which no one has been nominated, nominations for those offices will be held again on the second general membership meeting of the month, and voting will follow.

Offices for election are Exalted Ruler, Leading Knight, Loyal Knight, Lecturing Knight, Secretary, Treasurer, and 5-year Trustee. The remaining Stations of the Lodge are appointed by the newly elected Exalted Ruler. These are the Tiler, Inner Guard, Chaplain, and Esquire. Although our Lodge has a customary progression "through the chairs", any member in good standing is eligible for these offices or stations.

Also appointed by the ER (Exalted Ruler) are the Committee Chairmen. A brief listing of these committees can be found in this Bugle, under the picture of your current officers. These chairs are responsible for the events, activities, and functioning of the Lodge. Some are required by the Grand Lodge, others are not. The output of these committees is what allows our Lodge to excel. Their work is very important.

And this is where YOU come in! If you have wanted to get involved with our Lodge but didn't quite know how, this is where it happens. Come to the meetings this month and let myself or the newly elected officers know that you want to join them in making this upcoming year even better than the last. "Fresh Blood" always brings new ideas and enthusiasm, and we welcome both. Don't worry about not knowing how or what to do; there is plenty of training and mentoring available. You will not be alone. Your participation is what allows us to carry out the good work that we as Elks do. After all, this Lodge, and Elkdom itself, cannot operate without its volunteers.

There were about 200 people at this event including foster parents and over 100 children. There were children everywhere! Joyous chaos is what PER Mary Lou Scribner described the day. The Christmas theme was pajama party. Foster parents, children, and even volunteers dressed in Christmas pajamas and Christmas attire. There were snowball fights, a hot chocolate bar, and a delicious meal for the children. Each child received shopping bag to go around tables to select Christmas items, toiletries, socks, pajamas, and blankets supplied by the Family Forever organization. And, there was a station for the children to secretly select gifts for their parents which were wrapped by Brandon Lady and Elk Charlene Hart and her friend.

No Christmas party could be complete without a visit from Santa! Elk volunteer James Lair stepped in as Santa (at the request of good ole St. Nick!) and each child had a visit with Santa and picked out a toy, thanks to the Walgreens annual toy drive (chaired by the lodges Past Exalted Rulers Association).

The day's event is chaired by Past Lady President Terri Ciesla and was put a success due to 15 lodge volunteers. In addition, Elk members chose individual children's names from wish list cards and donated the child's Christmas. The lodge also donated \$1,100 from their charity account to complete the Christmas for an additional 29 children.
