Elk of the Month

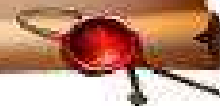

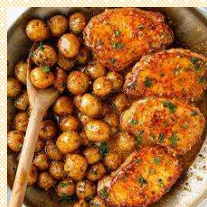

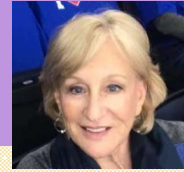

In record speed B.L.O.E. and B.P.O.E. members stepped up and volunteered to cook, set-up, organize, decorate, clean-up, pick out and organize toys to work with Santa. There were many volunteer hands in making this event such a huge success. Thank you to each and every one of you!

Somehow, not sure just how, Annie and Terri talked Mark Fox into being "Santa". Mark did an absolutely fantastic job as Santa. The line of kids waiting to tell him what they wanted for Christmas went on forever. And because of the toys gathered from the Walgreens Toy Drive, Santa was able to let each child pick out a toy to take home. Thank you, Mark, (or should I say Santa)! Hope you will do it again next year. And Christmas wouldn't be Christmas without a visit from the Grinch..... so in character..... Donald Harrison. Thank you...always there for the kids!

Santa spent time with 15 children and each good little boy and girl was provided a Christmas toy. The "Breakfast with Santa" has become an annual event that the kids and our members look forward to. Even our Lady President Annie Fox, took the opportunity to tell Santa her wish list for Christmas!



Brandon Lodge #2383 Uses Gratitude Grant to feed the Community!



Our used its Gratitude Grant to support two local organizations that continue to bridge the gap between crisis and stability. Nativity Food Pantry provides food to 140+ families and to several local food missions. ECHO provides food, clothing, and access to life-stabilizing resources such as computer training and resume creation. In November PER Mary Lou Scribner and PDD Sharon Hammersla divided the grant funds of \$2,500 to support these two great organizations. They went shopping and purchased the groceries most needed by each organization and delivered the food to ECHO on November 17th and to Nativity Food Pantry on November 22nd. The goal of both organizations is to support our community and alleviate food insecurity. A total of over 2,000 pounds of food were provided to these two organizations.

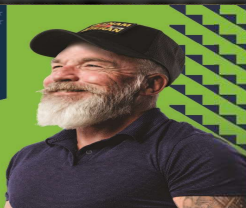
