PURPOSE OF THE B.P.O.E. #2383 PAST EXALTED RULER ASSOCIATION

We continue to give thanks to all our lodge members who have donated clothes, hygiene products, and food through either online ordering or the donation bin set up in the lounge. 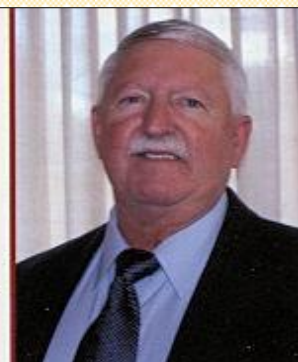
