Looking forward to getting back to you ladies and planning our events for the remainder of the year.



Bags of Brotherly Love for May and June

Again, we were not able to reach out to the homeless with our Bags of Brotherly Love for the May roving outreach. However, we were still able to help the homeless sheltered in 2 hotels. LaQuinta Inns in Tampa and Brandon are housing about 60 homeless through grants from Hillsborough County Homeless Initiative. They have the shelter, but no real access to food. There are small microwaves and refrigerators in the rooms. Bags of Brotherly Love donated food items that can be microwaved and the hotels are able to furnish the refrigeration for freezer and refrigerated items that can then be passed out to the homeless on a daily as need basis. Non-perishables of snack items and drinks are also supplied through our donation and very much appreciated. We also supply the hotels with coffee, sugar, and creamer since they provide that beverage 24/7 in their lobby areas. We are in communication with the Hillsborough County Homeless Initiative and no plans were made for a June quarterly outreach as of May 11th. Again, we thank all of our members for their continued support with this project and will communicate any quarterly outreach activity as soon as we know. The Fruits Of Our Endeavors

The BPOE and the BLOE are very well known for their scholarship programs. Each May we have a banquet at our lodge recognizing the outstanding High School Seniors in our area and award them with scholarships. A month or so later we receive a thank-you letter, and usually never hear from them again. Here is an exception. In 2009 Marissa

Ciesla won \$1000 from our Brandon Lodge. Together with other scholarships and the Florida Prepaid Program she began her education at the University of South Florida. She joined our lodge in 2011, after turning 21, making her the youngest member of our lodge at that time. She also has the distinction of being the ONLY scholarship recipient to have ever joined our lodge.

Here is her Bio:

Marissa Ciesla graduated in 2009 from Brandon Senior High School where she was president of her senior class. In 2012 she received a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Florida in biomedical sciences with minors in psychology and biomedical physics. In 2014 Marissa continued her education at the University of South Florida obtaining a Master of Science degree in medical sciences with a concentration in neuroscience. In 2015 Marissa entered the College of Medicine's Graduate Program in Biomedical Sciences at the University of Florida. During her PhD research, Marissa studied therapies to enhance serotonergic reinnervation of motor nuclei after cervical spinal cord injury (a way of improving the breathing ability of people with a damaged spinal cord in their neck). She also authored and published 5 papers in support of her research. On June 19, 2020, she successfully defended her thesis to obtain her PhD.

6. Hand Sanitizing dispensers are located at all entrances and outside restroom areas.


