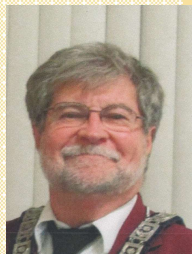

Charity and Brotherly Love. Now is the Time.

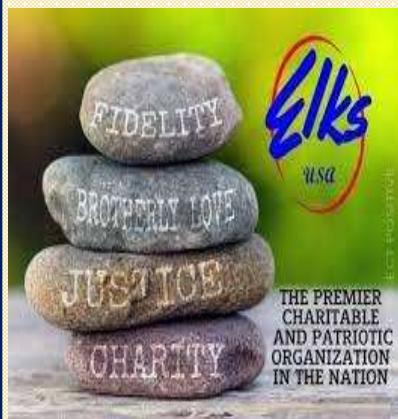

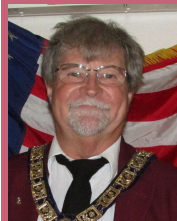
(who I also thank for their commitment), and to my knowledge, has only missed a couple nights in the last several months. That is commitment!
